



Welcome to the KSO 2022-2023 Concert season!

Our journey through the most beautiful masterworks of 21st century will begin with an opening night gala on October 22, 2022 at the Flato Markham Theatre, where we will also perform in December 2022 and February 2023. Then, in March, May and June 2023, we will reconnect with our beloved audience at the Richmond Hill Centre for the Performing Arts. In April 2023, we will co-present the 12th annual of Markham Contemporary Music Festival, in June 2023, we will conclude our season with a concert at the CBC Glenn Gould Studio, and in July 2023 with a Canada Day celebration at the Unionville Millennium Theatre.

Highlights of the season include Stravinsky's "Petrushka", Shostakovich's Symphony No. 4, Hindemith's Symphony "Mathis der Mahler", Bruckner's Symphony No. 2, Prokofiev's Symphony No. 7, Grieg's Symphony in c minor, and Honegger's Symphony No. 2.

We are excited to welcome the return of National Arts Centre Principal Cellist Rachel Mercer in Lalo's Concerto for Cello and Orchestra, acclaimed pianist Michael Berkovsky in Tchaikovsky's Second Piano Concerto, emerging violinist Emmanuelle Sievers in Stravinsky's Violin Concerto, and renowned violinist Jing Ye in the "Butterfly Lovers" Violin Concerto by He Zhanhao and Chen Gang. Renowned pianist Alexander Panizza will make his début with the KSO in Strauss's "Burlesque" and American violinist Andrew Sords will present Bruch's "Scottish Fantasy". Markham Contemporary Music Festival will feature pianist Antonia de Wolfe in pieces by Hindemith and Górecki and Polish conductor Bartosz Żurakowski in masterworks by Prokofiev.


Stay warm this December as the KSO presents a concert of strikingly programmatic music filled with machinery, fantasy and folklore. "Locomotives vibrate in harmony" with Honegger's mechanically modernistic mouvement symphonique: Pacific 231. Jing Ye narrates with her violin the Chinese "Romeo and Juliet" folk tale, The Butterfly Lovers - a story of broken hearts, beautifully set to music that merges eastern melodies with western instruments. 




Artistic inspiration comes in many forms. The joy of sport is decidedly prevalent in the rhythmically rowdy Rugby by the avantgarde Swiss-French composer Honegger. At the request of his publisher, and in collaboration with a seasoned American violinist, Stravinsky penned his brightly bombastic neo-baroque Concerto for Violin and orchestra en Ré. Motivated by the doctrine of Socialist Realism, Shostakovich withdrew the score of his enormously orchestrated Symphony no. 4, only to be performed 25 years after its creation.





As a wedding present to the daughter of his most influential teacher, **Stravinsky** gifts the speedy fantasy entitled Fireworks - an early work that foreshadows the composer's impending fame. Taking centre stage is acclaimed pianist Alexander Panizza in performance of the Bramhsian-flavoured *Burleske* by German composer **Richard Strauss**, another young and prophetic piece on this program. In his orchestral suite Mathis der Maler, **Hindemith** finds balance between bliss and abomination to portray a musical portrait of a 15<sup>th</sup> century altarpiece and the life of German painter Matthias Grünewald.



Join Maestro Kristian Alexander as he leads the KSO through a spirited journey of musical passion and panache. Master Russian orchestrator Rimsky-Korakov brings Spanish flair to his musical travelogue filled with fun and fandango: Capriccio Espagnol. Composing out of pure innercompulsion, and wherever his travels took him (Berlin, Paris, Rome and Russia) Tchaikovsky brings ingenuity and innovation to his virtuosic and unorthodox Concerto for Piano no. 2. Symphony no. 2 showcases Bruckner's distinctive gradual-build of intensity, exuberant climaxes and powerful sudden pauses of silence - the beginning of what audiences now call "Bruckneresque."





### **CONCERT ETIQUETTE**

#### Portable electronic devices

Please be sure to turn off your cellular phones, pagers, watch alarms, and other audible electronic devices before the concert begins. Please also take a break from reading or sending text messages during the performance.

#### Cameras and audio recorders

Cameras and other recording devices are not permitted in the concert hall.

#### Accessibility

All venues are wheelchair accessible including entrances, washrooms, and seating.

#### Coughing

Everyone coughs now and then. The less worried you are about coughing, the less likely you are to feel the urge to do so. If you must, try to cough during a loud passage of music. If you cannot control your cough, please quietly exit the concert hall.

#### **Applause**

Although at one time it was common to applaud at any time during the performance, modern audiences usually hold their applause until the end of an entire piece, i.e. after the last movement has ended.

#### **Duration of the performance**

The Kindred Spirits Orchestra's performances are usually two hours including one intermission. Some concerts are 90 minutes long and special events may vary in length from one hour without intermission to 3 hours with two intermissions.

#### Dress code

Although there is no formal dress code, most guests wear business or business casual attire.

#### Multiple chemical sensitivity syndrome (MCSS)

Some guests are sensitive to fragrances or have allergies, asthma or other respiratory conditions. Please refrain from wearing scented products when at the concert hall.



What is Subscription? Subscription includes tickets to 3 or more concerts of your choice from the KSO main season. Save 20% off standard single tickets prices and if you are a full time student, or under 18, or over 65, save even more.

Easy ticket exchanges. If you cannot make it to a particular concert, you can exchange your tickets for another concert in the season, subject to availability, 24 hours prior to the concert. It's a free service and exchanges can be made by phone, mail, or in person, anytime up to immediately before the performance. You can also donate your ticket back to the KSO for an income tax donation receipt.

Value. Save 20% off an adult single ticket price, 35% if you are 65 y.o. and older, and 60% if you are a full-time student or under 18.

Priority seating. Book the best seats in the house before tickets go on sale to the general public.

**Guaranteed seating.** With guaranteed seats, you won't have to stand in box office lines, or risk missing a performance because of sold-out concerts.

Renewal privileges. You can keep your seats for years to come or you can choose different seats when you renew.
